It's by completely different people, but they were inspired by AMV Hell, and it's done in the same style, and it's of the same quality. My only beef with it is it uses mostly mainstream, popular, well known shows more often than not. Sure there are some niche titles, but they lean toward the more well known series when they can. Black Lagoon, Excel Saga, Azumanga Daioh, Bleach, Gurren Lagann, Naruto, EVA, Cowboy Bebop, Trigun etc. So while the original AMV Hells had lots of more niche titles in it along with the powerhouses, this is like only anime EVERYONE will know. (there are a few really niche titles like "Super Gals" and Puni Puni Poemy" though so keep an eye out for them). Still it's well worth a watch. Other than that, this is another perfect AMV hell spiritual successor to watch. Very funny, and very well done. Even the ending credits are done in AMV Hell style. And an amazing song (that I never heard before). be sure to stay after the credits for one final joke!
